


Require EDI 997 Functional Acknowledgements and track them.





Transmit and receive data as close to real-time as possible.





Have a full EDI strategy: EDI *FAST*rack[™] / Seldon[™] Webforms Enthus[™] eCommerce / EDI Certification Campaign





Don't use e-mail to transport documents.





Consider Item Synchronization with every new trading partner.





Implement "reverse" purchase orders.





Replace faxing with low-cost webforms, or EDI-to-FAX





Require EDI 856 Advance Shipping Notices to reflect what exactly has been shipped.





Do 3-way matching if your ERP system supports it. If not, consider having York perform the match against your EDI data.





Remember your vendor's point of view: Be no more specific in your requirements than necessary to achieve the goal, and favor public standards over proprietary specifications.





Value your POS data!1) Vendor managed inventory2) B.I. strategy





Have an EDI champion!





Use PO Acknowledgement (855), PO Change (EDI 860), PO Change Acknowledgement (865) IF they reflect how you purchase.





Direct Ship from your eCommerce site via EDI with custom shipping labels; charge credit cards triggered by Advance Shipping Notices (856)





Embed APIs into your internal applications for seamless access to the EDI process.
